

Senator Scofield. Senator Byars, please. Senator Pirsch. Senator McFarland, the house is under call. Senator Robak. Senator Moore, would you check in, please. Senator Schmit, Senator Peterson, Senator McFarland. Senator Robak. Senator Ashford. Senator Bernard-Stevens. A roll call vote has been requested. Proceed with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See pages 2246-47 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Moore would move to amend.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: This amendment, quite simply what it would do is fully fund a request to reroof a building at the State Fair. I mean this as serious because I think the roof needs to be built. We are going so good today, we can't say no to anything. We are going to continue...we can't say no to any capital construction requests, you know. It is going to be awful hard for me to stand up here again the rest of the session and say there is not enough money to fund Commonwealth, and there is not enough money for aquaculture and protocol and other stuff like that, but even though I'd really like to run this amendment because the building was built in 1913. If the building falls down, we are going to spend several million dollars to rebuild it, we would like to...you know several hundred thousand people go through that building every year. Probably more people go through that building than the Mead facility Senator Schmit talked to or the facility...that more people run through this building than the pigs go through Bernard-Stevens building we just built there, but I ask to withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Warner, would you care to make the motion?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 814 be advanced to E & R Initial.
