SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Warner, any closing The question is then the adoption of Thank you. Section 4 of the committee amendments to 525. All in favor vote aye, opposed may. Have you all voted? Please record.

28 ayes, 1 may, Mr. President, on adoption of Section 4 of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Section 4 is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have Section 5 from the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is the same concept as was in Section 4, only covers counties. The county amount is slightly less because the amount of their current aid is slightly less than municipalities, but the concept of the percentage increase is the same, and I would move adoption of this. It would be an additional 2.2 million, approximately, the first year, 4.1 million the second year. It runs in my mind the current total distribution is around 17 million as I recall.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? Any questions? If not, those in favor of the adoption of Section 5 please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.
