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hope that it comes to a vote shortly. I will give Senator Landis any more of my time if he wants it.

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute.

SENATOR NELSON: Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I want to divide the question. We have two rules and portions of them that are being discussed before us and I want to divide the question. And one of the rules being suspended is the rule dealing with the division of the question and I don't want that rule taken out. I don't want it suspended.

SENATOR LABEDZ: (Microphone not on) ... a ruling from the Chair whether that can be done.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers, frankly, I didn't hear the request. Would you repeat it?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. Mr. Chairman, this is a motion to suspend a number of rules and I have moved for a division of the question because the rules are separate and distinct and besides a ruling that allowed a division of the question on one of these motions had been made earlier in the session.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. Speaker, aren't we reconsidering the vote?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Excuse me, please, Senator Labedz. Senator Chambers, it occurs to the Chair that we are considering now a reconsideration motion. We're not on the division or the suspension.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, oh it's...

SPEAKER BARRETT: On the reconsideration and in that event it would not be in order.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Wait a minute. Tell me when it would not be in order. When the rule suspension is before us, that question cannot be divided, you're saying.

SPEAKER BARRETT: We're now on the reconsideration motion.
