bracket motion. The people of the State of Nebraska will be watching the next two votes and so will I. This is a very important bill to me and many of the parents in the State of Nebraska. I have received many calls. There are many people that can't believe that the Legislature, in any way, is saying that the parents don't have a right to know. The bracket motion, the reconsideration and then the vote and first the reconsideration vote which takes 25, then the bracket motion which takes 25, and then the suspension of the rules. Bernard-Stevens mentioned that we will be going on this for hours and hours additionally. It will not be on General File because if I receive 30 votes to suspend the rules with no further debate or amendments, the bill, no doubt, will move to Select File. Whether or not it will ever reach Final Reading is not as important to me as these next two votes and to the people of the State of Nebraska. I have 30 co-sponsors. I am sure that probably at least three or four are excused so it's going to be very difficult to get the 30 votes. But the reconsideration vote is up now. There are 25 votes needed here, 30 votes on the suspension of the rules, and there will be no further debate. We will move on to Senator Chambers' bill, Senator Bernard-Stevens kept saying we will be on this LB 588. for hours and hours and hours. That's not true. It's the next two votes that count. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. You have heard the closing and the question is a motion to reconsider, to suspend the rules. It takes 25 votes. Those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to reconsider? Senator Labedz.
