I believe that we have treated and we have increased the funds for the local monitoring committee substantially. Those funds ought to be adequate. If they are not adequate, then I would be willing to stand here, Senator Kristensen, another year and give you additional funds if you needed them, but I would prefer that we do not adopt this portion of your amendment. I would prefer that we divide the amendment, divide the question, and we vote on them separately. I oppose the first half of your amendment. I would not oppose the second half of your amendment, and I do not agree with you, unfortunately, that the first half is not controversial. I believe it is controversial. I believe it should not be adopted and I would ask for a division of the question.

PRESIDENT: We will divide the question and we will take the first half now. Senator Schmit, I assume you want to split it between 17 and 18, lines 17 and 18, so that we will talk about the money the first part, and then we will talk about...
