LB 761

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I just have a question and I guess maybe Senator Lamb would be the appropriate person to ask. It relates to a conversation we had earlier today. I'm looking at the fiscal note of a General Fund appropriation of \$146,000, fairly sizeable Cash Fund appropriation and in my bill book I don't see an appropriation, an A bill, accompanying this. Is there, in fact, an A bill with LB 761?

SENATOR LAMB: I don't know, Senator. We would have to look.

SENATOR WITHEM: Senator Schmit, is there an A bill with LB 761?

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit, Senator Withem would like to ask you a question. Would you be so kind as to respond?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Would you ask him again, Senator Withem, please?

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I'm just...I'm noting in the...this actually carries on with the conversation that Senator Haberman had with me this morning so maybe he would like to get involved in it also. LB 761, I noticed the revised fiscal note has a General Fund appropriation of \$146,000, a Cash Fund appropriation of considerable dollars, I don't see an A bill in my book. Is there, in fact, an appropri...a separate A bill, 761A, that's just not in my book, or...?

SENATOR SCHMIT: No, there is not, Senator Withem. The funding will have to be provided for in the regular appropriations bill, 813, I believe. It will be reflected in there.

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay, it will be...and Senator Haberman says there is one that has been filed here on this bill also? So, okay, I was just curious because of discussion we had this morning if we were going to be consistent with A bills accompanying these or not. Thank you very much.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Lynch, please. The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. And the question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.
