PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Recorder not activated) ...Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning as our Chaplain of the day, the Reverend Lee Hankins of the First Christian Church in Lincoln. Would you please rise for the invocation.

REVEREND LEE HANKINS: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Reverend Hankins. We appreciate that this morning. Roll call, please.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do you have any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this point in time, I have no messages, reports or announcements.

PRESIDENT: Well, we will move on to Select File, appropriation bills, the first one, LB 813.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 813 is on Select File. The first order of business are adoption of Enrollment and Review amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lynch, would you move the adoption of the E & R amendments for us, please?

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to 813.
