Senator Hall has guests from the Assumption School in Omaha. have 18 eighth graders and their teacher. Would you folks please stand so we may recognize you. Thank you for visiting us Senator Warner, would you record your presence, please. Thank you. Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you record your presence. Thank you. We're looking for Senator Moore, Senator Labedz, would you record your presence, Goodrich. please. Thank you. Senator Baack, Senator Chambers, Goodrich. We're looking for Senator Pirsch, Senator Baack and Senator Moore. All are here now that are not excused. Did you ask for a roll call vote, Senator Hannibal? The question is the adoption of the Hannibal amendment to the Hall amendment and a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 2396 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. What is next, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: We're back to Senator Hall's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The call is raised. Senator Hannibal, your light is on. We're on the Hall amendment.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. President, I rise now to support the Hall amendment. We have, I guess, made a decision that we want to proceed with this program without knowing what the rules and regulations are going to be, but Senator Hall has brought to us an amendment that does fix the amendment that was placed on General File because he does allow for rules and regulation promulgation in this change and he also allows for some administrative cost to go to the operations of the Department of Education so that we can at least administrer this program in some organized fashion. So while I do disagree with the policy and while I do disagree with the aid funds, especially at this time, I believe it would be irresponsible for us to not change the amendment and put it in more proper form which Senator Hall has brought to us, so I will support this amendment.
