CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend. I have AM1845, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. There is an amendment there to strike the first amendment, the first committee amendment which actually was dealt with earlier this morning on Senator Hall's amendment dealing with the textbook loan program. So I would just move that that amendment be adopted in order to strike that provision from the committee amendment, since it's already been dealt with.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Is it clear to the Chair, Senator Warner, that we are on amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, sir, and it would be amendment number one that we would be striking from the amendment, because we have already dealt with it.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: There will be then, Mr. President, there will be three amendments, two, three and four, that we will...I'll ask for a division of the question on each of those so they can be handled separately.

SPEAKER BARRETT: We're now on number one.

SENATOR WARNER: That is to eliminate it and leave the Senator Hall amendment adopted earlier this morning intact, as is.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Is there discussion? Senator Hall. Senator Wesely. Anything further, Senator Warner? The question is then the adoption of the amendment to the amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to his amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Now, Mr. President, could I ask to have a
