No. There is no consulting engineers. Are there any people says this is a good investment? No, there is nobody says that this is a good investment. You just have a bunch of people there that can be influenced in a lot of ways. Well, it isn't our \$10 million, let's run with it. Now, if they would have gone after this and hired a consulting engineer, hired an investment officer and done this is in a workmanship, businesslike manner we wouldn't be in this problem talking about whether they need 10 million or 17 million. I talked to a man a month ago,...

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...and I said, how much money do you need if Farmland Industries comes into Nebraska? He says, all \$17 million, I want it all. So I say to you, I think the Appropriations Committee made the proper decision when they said, let's give them a million plus, see what they do for a year, see what they come up with, then if they come up with something that is substantial we'll let them have some more. So I oppose the amendment to open this Pandora's Box up and give somebody \$10 million, because there is a lot of people out there in those bushes that sure would like to...I'd like to get my hands on \$10 million that I could spend to promote my own business, as long as I got a piece of the action, then if it went down the tube, heck, it isn't my \$10 million, no, it's those farmers who paid the checkoff money.

PRESIDENT: Time.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Moore, please, followed by Senator Warner and then Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. President and members. To begin with I have a question first of Senator Baack, if he'd so yield.

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack, please.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR MOORE: Senator Baack, if I heard you correctly Senator Schellpeper asked you whether or not these funds could be used to purchase or expand the plant, your answer was no. Is that
