SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 3 nays, to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: House is under call. Members, please record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return. Senator Byars, please. Senator Chambers. Senators Haberman and Schmit, the house is under call. Senators Haberman and Schmit, please report to the Chamber. Senator Ashford, would you please check in? Senator Rod Johnson, please check in. May we proceed? Senator Haberman is the only one out. Thank you. Roll call has been requested on the adoption of the amendment. Mr. Clerk, proceed.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote read as found on pages 2431-32 in the Legislative Journal.) Senator Coordsen voting no. Vote is 18 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion fails. Next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: What number the amendment?

SPEAKER BARRETT: The call is raised. I would urge the body to stay, again, close to the Chamber. It will save some time. Senator Warner.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The amendment number is 1307, Senator. (The Warner amendment appears on pages 2432-34 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I just want to make sure that what I'm speaking about is the amendment. What this amendment does is this amendment is one that was...is necessary. It makes no change in any funding. This deals with the Student Scholarship Funds, and what ths amendment does, under past history, the match funds that went to the public institutions were placed in their appropriation.
