the department comes back and says, well, we need 10 million dollars now because that Adjustment Center was not built to alleviate the problem of overcrowding, it was for something else, then people are going to say, well, gee, I didn't know that. But that's what I keep trying to emphasize. The Adjustment Center, the size of it, is not why there's overcrowding in the prison. I'm not going to drag this discussion out interminably,...

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..but there were some things I felt had to be in the record so that whatever we do we can look back to this day.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I'll call the question.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The question has been called. Five hands? I do. Shall debate close? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Chambers to close.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, when this matter came before us a few days ago, I think it was two or three votes short of the number of votes needed. going to make the pitch that others have made when they were trying to remove money from the budget. There are other programs involving established needs. This is over \$4 million which has not been justified in terms of an expenditure. If the construction does not occur then we'll see what happens, and I will tell you that there are judges who are going to review the way they handle sentencing. But if the types of things can be brought to this Legislature on the floor as I have done, discussed before the committee with the Chief Justice in the way that it was, and the Legislature's conduct not be influenced by those discussions and those disclosures, there is no incentive for the system to improve. I hope that the votes are here to take that money out and then we can go to the Appropriation Committee's amendment that will deal with the study. Mr. Chairman, I'm going to ask for a call of the house and then
