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reduced in size 24,677 feet; the greenhouse and the head house reduced in size 34,292 feet. Construction costs were left at 61 dollars a square foot for the lab building; 25 dollars a square foot for the greenhouses. As near as we could tell, and I don't know where the information started, but from as near as we can tell the quality of the work was as they had planned, but they reduced the size about a third in order to compensate for the reduction in the funds that they had available. The fiberglass didn't last. They asked for a 25-year warranty; received a 20-year limited warranty from a company that ultimately, in the interim, went bankrupt. Because of the deterioration of the fiberglass and the reduction in the light units that were transmitted, the ventilation systems, the heating systems all had to work 20-30 times more than what they were designed for to control the environment. I would suggest to you that the \$737,000 included in this amendment is money that would be wisely spent to invest in the future of the State of Nebraska to continue our progress in agricultural instruction, in agronomy and entomology and plant physiology and all of the disciplines that exist out there, those disciplines that provide for private industry...

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...the research people that have been so great to us. But I am also aware of the passage of time and the constraints we're under today. And, after the next sentence, I will tell you that I am going to withdraw this amendment. But the next sentence is that I fully intend to introduce this bill, this amendment as a capital construction bill for whatever capital funds are available the next session of the Legislature and I guarantee you that I will work and many others on this body will work with all of the abilities they have to ensure that Nebraska, 75 percent dependent on our trade, on agriculture...

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time has expired.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...to continue our position. And, with that, Mr. Speaker, I would ask to have this amendment withdrawn.

SPEAKER BARRETT: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend. Senator, I have AM1789 in front of me.
