SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment to make some corrections, adds no money, there are four items in it. One is a correct program number, accounting number for the renovation of legislative space. It's not in the bill. The prior appropriations made the program 905, not program 900 as shown in the original LB 814. So that just corrects that. Then the next amendment deals with Games and Parks and it's reappropriation language for a...well, it adds language reappropriating '89-90 balances to '90-91 for new projects as quoted in the Game Commission and the reappropriation language in LB 813 does not apply to this bill and the reappropriation language has shown that Section 59 only applies to programs under numbers that relate to projects currently under construction, not new projects initiated this year. So all this does, it reappropriates money between the...from the first year to the second year the project is not completed. The third amendment reappropriates specific amounts specific projects in the Game Commission. These were projects that had been approved in the previous year but have not yet been completed and we went back in and looked at all of the various capital construction projects that Game and Parks have had over a period of time and in that process eliminated some because the reappropriation was not needed but in a cases there are and it runs in my mind there's five. I could indicate what they are but they're nothing new. And then the fourth one is a reappropriation also of the unexpended balance. This happens to be what the University of Nebraska but they were projects that were thought...that were previously authorized initially thought would be completed by June 30th but that we three of the various projects will not be reappropriates those unexpended balances because the contracts or the construction renovation work, finalized safety work will not be completed before June 30th so that the checks...warrants could not be drawn. I would move adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Abboud, would you care to discuss the amendment? Senator Abboud. Senator Landis, on the amendment. There has been no discussion, however, Senator Warner's is the only other light. Thank you. Senator Warner. Thank you. Shall the amendment be adopted? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.
