SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. President and members of the body, I will try to be very brief. You have in front of you two maps; the smaller one which shows a segment of land that is about southeast of the Lincoln Regional Center and the longer map shows the Lincoln Correctional Center with a long strip of land just to the west of it that's about 15 acres. The land southeast of the Regional Center is about 24 1/2 acres. And what this amendment would do, it would authorize the Department of Administrative Services to enter into negotiations to acquire the 15 acres of land west of the correctional facilities and as part of the negotiations to offer and use as consideration the 24 1/2 acres that is right southeast of the Lincoln Regional Center. And the value of both of these properties is comparable. There may be a little bit of a revenue that will come to the State of Nebraska that would go into the vacant building fund. The land that's southeast of the Regional Center is one that's already surplus property. I would ask your consideration.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Is there discussion? Seeing none, Senator Schimek, anything further? Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Schimek amendment to LB 814. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend. Senator, I have AM1844 in front of me.
