30 ayes...I'm sorry, Mr. President, 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion by Senator Hall has been adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend by adding the severability clause. (The Warner amendment appears on page 2440 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I so move. As I indicated. this...obviously we need to suspend the rules but there may be an outside possibility of two subject matters and in the event that challenge would be there it's important that the body of the bill, as it now stands without this amendment, is not jeopardized. So I would move the adoption of the severability clause to the extent that that would help.

SENATOR LAMB: Any further discussion in regard to Senator Warner's motion? If not, those in support of the motion signify by voting aye, those opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, O nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Warner's amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The Chair recognizes Senator Chizek, on the bill.

SENATOR CHIZEK: I think somebody...I think. Never mind.

LAMB: Senator Chizek waives off. Any further discussion on LB...the advancement of LB 309? If not, Senator Warner, do you care to close? The motion is the advancement of Those in support say aye, those opposed no. Ayes have it, the bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 309A, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending, first of all, Mr. President.
