

Thank you, Senator Warner, for yielding a little bit of time. What I wanted to do was explain to you why I did for one year, and that it is a supplemental approach to LB 84 and since LB 84 is only going to be into effect for, for sure, the first year, it didn't make much sense to stick in \$18 million and, thus, maybe Senator Warner is trying to kill me with kindness by adding more frosting onto this cake, Senator Chambers, in order to get people to vote for it so they later can not vote for it. And after listening to you, Senator Chambers, I guess, you know it really reminds me after your speech that sometimes if you don't know where you're going you might end up somewhere else, and you reminded me of that in the way you spoke the last time, but thank you for the support and I wanted to make sure that the membership knew why we put in 18 million for just one year. Basically it is to coincide with LB 84 and its provisions and not to extend it out and make it more vulnerable to later attack in other branches of government. Thank you.

SENATOR LAMB: Thank you. The motion is the adoption of the Senator Warner amendment to the Kristensen amendment. Those in support vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. We'll continue discussion on the amendment by Senator Kristensen. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. President and members, you know Senator Kristensen is indeed a quick study. He is a quick study on how this Legislature works and the Legislature usually work, it seems like, is that we don't say no, we say yes. We say yes to everybody. Going back to the political maxims that Senator Chambers talked about, you know John Kennedy was often quoted, in politics nobody gets everything, nobody gets nothing, everybody gets something. Well, you know this Legislature it almost seems like we're going to erase that and say, everybody gets everything because we're not going to say no to anybody. You know two months ago I offered an amendment to LB 89 for \$20 million in state aid. At that time I said Chizek would be doing cartwheels any other year. The state aid proponents would be doing cartwheels any other year. Now, they don't want to dare take on the teachers, no. Say no to the teachers? No way.
