ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as it appears on pages 2510-2511 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 277A passes. LB 280.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 280 on Final Reading.)
