favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, it is advanced.

Mr. President, the next bill I have is LB 817A, and, Senator, I have no amendments to that bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 817A, Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that LB 817A be advanced to E & R Final.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall 817A be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, the bill is advanced.

Senator, I next have LB 815A. I do have E & R amendments to that bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 815A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to 815A. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, they are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that LB 815A, as amended, be advanced to E & R Final.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall 815A, as amended, be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, the bill is advanced. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, have you an item on the desk?

Mr. President, I do. I have a motion from Senator McFarland to direct the Clerk to request the return from the Governor of LB 228 for further consideration.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator McFarland. Senator Withem, proceed.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Senator McFarland has asked me to handle this amendment. This was an Education Committee bill. If you recall, it's one that we passed yesterday. LB 228 was a bill
