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SENATOR WITHEM: If you want me to respond, yes, we did have to have a bill brought back.

SENATOR SMITH: All right, all right. So, you know this happens in here. I changed my mind, Senator Withem, after I heard the floor discussion and the debate. Finally, my last point is you also alluded, the first time we had the discussion and again this time, I didn't clarify it that time, I just handed you a copy of the amendment which you were talking about which said I was striking Phase I. If you read the amendment now, do you see what I was doing? I actually struck Phase II in that amendment, retaining Phase I. And by the advice of the bill drafters, who told me you don't need to talk about phases because now you only have one phase, so Phase I was the phase I was leaving in my amendment. That's my clarification...

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time has expired.

SENATOR SMITH: ...and I would just ask you to decide that this is something that is a fairness issue, all teachers should be included, if we're going to vote for this 2 million dollar, or 20 million dollars, and I'll give the rest of my time to Senator Lamb. Thank you. (Laughter.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Time has expired. You've heard the closing. The question is the return of the bill to Select File. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: I would like a roll call vote, please. Are we under call?

SPEAKER BARRETT: We are under call.

SENATOR SMITH: I would like to have a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. A roll call vote has been requested. Would members please check in. We are technically under call. Members, record your presence. Those members off the floor, please return and record your presence. Senators Baack, Chambers, Schmit, and Warner, the house is under call. Senators Baack and Warner, the house is under call. Mr. Clerk, proceed with the roll call.
