SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 308E passes. LB 309E.

CLERK: (Read LB 309E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 309, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2559-60 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 309E passes. LB 309A with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 309A on Final Reading.)

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2560-61 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
