CLERK: (Began taking roll call vote.)

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) The Clerk can't hear your response, let's hold it down, please.

(Roll call vote taken. See pages 2572-73 of the Legislative Journal.) 8 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President.

The amendment to the amendment fails. Do you have anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

Yes, Mr. President, I do. Your Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor bill read on Final Reading this morning, Mr. President. LB 377 is reported as correctly Engrossed. (See pages 2574-75 of the Legislative Journal.)
