the next year the fiscal note has been reduced down from 677,000 to 595,000. And, also since my original bill had the Department of Education to administer it, and it was amended on the floor to have the Health Department administer it. And since it is now not as simple as it was originally, and does have to do with student loans and granting loans and so on, they are asking for an additional fund to administer the program. And, with that, I will answer any questions. If not, I move for the...to return the bill to Select File.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Schellpeper, please.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I just want to make the point that this is one of the few times that we can save some money. This A bill comes in at about \$303,000 less than what it was, so I think we have that much more money that we can use again. So, there is \$303,000 here less than what the estimate was the first time. So I would just urge you to advance the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any closing on it, Senator Nelson?

SENATOR NELSON: No, I think I've made it clear. As I say, I'm happy to find one that I can reduce a little bit, maybe I'll have a little better chance.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question is the return of the bill to Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the return of the bill. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: I move for the adoption of the amendment.
