SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 183 passes. LB 183A.

CLERK: (Read LB 183A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 2609 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 6 nays, 2 present not voting, 2 excused not voting.
