CLERK: Mr. President, Revenue Committee, chaired by Senator Hall, would report on the appointments of Mr. Kipton Hirschbach and Doralene Weed to the Nebraska Agricultural Land Valuation Advisory Board.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. The Revenue Committee held the confirmation hearings on these two individuals, Doralene Weed from Kearney and Kipton Hirschbach from Norfolk for appointments to the Nebraska Agricultural Land Valuation Advisory Board replacing a couple of individuals whose terms had expired, and I would urge the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the report. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Revenue Committee confirmation report.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is accepted. The General Affairs Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President, the General Affairs Committee chaired by...whoop, wrong committee, Senator, excuse me. General Affairs would report, Mr. President, on the appointments of Mary Cabela, Marilyn Mitchell, and Claudette Valentine to the Nebraska Arts Council.

PRESIDENT: Senator Smith, please.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Members of the body, the Governor recently appointed Mary Cabela of Sidney to complete the terms of a resigning member of the Nebraska Arts Council. That term ends in September of 1989, and appointed, as well, two other new members, three year members, to the Arts Council to replace individuals whose terms will be expiring, and these are Marilyn Mitchell of Norfolk and Claudette Valentine of Omaha. We conducted the confirmation hearing for the appointments and found these three individuals exhibited knowledge and interest in the arts, and they possess the desire to promote the arts and to improve the state's cultural resources through their work on the council. Therefore, by
