SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. President, and members, the Transportation Committee met yesterday in regard to these two appointments, Mr. Jim Carr to the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board, Vera Dulaney to the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. The motion was unanimous that these persons be confirmed. Lieutenant Governor, Bill Nichol, appeared on behalf of Vera Dulaney. She is the county clerk in Scotts Bluff County. She was unable to be present because they are holding protest hearings in the county. So under our rules, the committee voted unanimously to excuse Ms. Dulaney from appearing before the committee. The committee recommends that the report be adopted by the Legislature.
