very closely to this because my community has been very well benefitted from family practice graduates the last few years. We have a done a number of things during this session of the Legislatures and the past several sessions to try to encourage the enhancement of health care in outstate Nebraska and in all of Nebraska, but there is nothing more vital, there is nothing more vital than the providing the opportunity for people to further their education in those disciplines that will give them the background to be able to operate in a general practitioners operation in family practice. I think it is essential that we indicate that we do support the family practice program and that with this override we encourage the med center to provide the funding by whatever means, whatever means to continue this practice till we can make a little bit better arrangements to increase the funding per se for this program in another session of the Legislature. So I encourage the override of this particular veto and whatever time left I would give to Senator Schel peper.

SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Schellpeper, about three minutes.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Senator Coordsen, members, I also rise to support this worthwhile program. I want to just read some of the towns that these doctors have been sent to, Alma, Nebraska, Falls City, Wayne, Kearney, Hebron, Fremont, Beatrice, Geneva, Aurora, Tecumseh, Valentine, Columbus, Sidney, Albion, Falls City, Grand Island, Valentine, Central City, West Point. It's very important that we keep sending these doctors out there. We can't let this here program stop. I think it's a program that is very, very important to this state and I just urge the override of the veto. Thank you.
