this, I do believe that project is very important. It has been well managed and certainly the City of Omaha and its residents deserve some benefits from the Papio because they do make a substantial contribution to the Papio Natural Resources District collections. So I would ask you, gentlemen, again, and ladies, to view the fact that for 1.5 million we actually get a total expenditure of over 8 million of which 5.5 million plus is federal money. And so I'd ask you to support my motion to override.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Schmit was closing and the question is, shall the part of LB 813 be overridden as explained by Senator Schmit? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Schmit?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, notwithstanding my miserable showing, I'm going to ask for a call of the house and roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 18 ayes, no nays, to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please return to your seats and record your presence? Those not in the Chamber, please return promptly so that we may move on. Please return to your seats and record your presence. Looking for Senator Warner. Senator Moore, would you record your presence, please? Senator Labedz. Senator Hall. Looking for Senator Labedz. Senator Labedz, would you check in, please? Thank you. We're all here and it's a roll call vote, please, on the Schmit amendment. Could we please hold the conversation down so we can hear, please, especially under the balconies? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 2743-44 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Call is raised. Move on to the next one, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President the next motion I have is by Senator Schmit. Senator, this is to Agency 84, Section 80, Wastewater. Move that that section become law notwithstanding the objections
