

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is, shall that portion of LB 813 as explained by Senator Wesely be overridden? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Wesely?

SENATOR WESELY: Call of the house, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 2 nays, to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please return to your seats and record your presence? Those not in the Chamber, please return so that we may move on, but look up to see if your light is on. If not, please turn it on, please, like Senator Scofield, please. Senator Dennis Byars, please check in. Thank you. While we're waiting for the rest of the senators to return, may I introduce some guests, please, in the north balcony. Senator Robak and Senator Schmit have guests there. We have 43 sixth graders from Saint Isidore in Columbus, Nebraska. Sister Catherine is their teacher. Will you folks please stand and be recognized? Thank you for visiting us today. Senator Moore, would you check in, please? We're looking for Senator Warner, Senator Robak, Senator Coordsen. Now we're looking for Senator Coordsen. Please return to your seats so that we can begin here in a moment. We're looking for Senator Coordsen. Okay, we're all here. The roll call vote has been requested. Are you all in your seats, please, so we can begin? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 2745-46 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Move on to Senator Peterson's, please. Call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Peterson would move that Agency 25, Department of Public Institutions, Program 365, line-item veto become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.
