SENATOR MORRISSEY: Machine vote.

PRESIDENT: Machine vote, okay, record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Just a record vote, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. Vote appears on pages 2751-52 of the Legislative Journal.) 14 ayes, and 21 nays, Mr. President.
