true, because they have no ability to reallocate. But I just wanted to kind of make the point that there is a significant difference when you have vetoes with no reference to why they were reduced, just a number on the basis that the lower number is enough. This year we are dealing with some specifics, not only for the current year, but beyond that it shows us what items are a continuation item that carry on into the future, and those items are one time. And there is a significant difference in those kind of overrides, too, that I won't take the time to talk about. But, with that, I relinquish what time I have back to Senator Weihing.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Weihing.

SENATOR WEIHING: Mr. President and members, I want to clarify that the Governor has been very cooperative on this and is willing to work. I don't want to leave the impression that she certainly didn't know what she was doing, she did. The complexity within a budget, when I was speaking of engineering, this instructional equipment for engineering is within the systemwide request. And I simply want to clarify that there was a total with regards to that and not just a singular request for the engineering. The dialogue has begun, and going in the positive direction, and because of this I will withdraw my motion, my amendment. I request that it be withdrawn, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir, it is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, the next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bernard-Stevens would move to override Section 51 of the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I've been very careful to pick out if there were...to choose whether there were any areas that I really felt strong enough that I wanted to speak out in favor of overriding a veto and there were just a couple that I did speak out on, the first one being the rural health, getting family physicians out into the rural areas. I thought that was very important and I was pleased that the body saw fit to move that along. The second one on my list, and there was one other bill if we get to it, but otherwise I'll be pretty quiet today. Just for the record,
