

Atkinson that many of you don't know that I think should have some influence on how you might vote on this. There is a benefactor in Atkinson by the name of Ernie Weller (phonetic), who, when he passed away, left a foundation that provides scholarships for youth from that area. Last year, they provided \$185,000 worth of scholarships, something that I think should be weighed against the possibility of some influx back into that community. That's \$185,000 that is not...that is used by students in that area that will not be used from other sources in the state. So it looks to me like that...I'm not saying it's a trade-off. I'm just saying I think we ought to consider some of those things. I would seriously ask you to consider this override. I think that the people of that area have long had this due them. It's been part of their lifestyle. They use it as a fishing area. They use it as a camping area. It belongs to, actually, the State Game and Parks Commission. There has been enough interest in it that there was \$20,000 allocated for that project through the NRD area up there and it looks to me like this is an opportunity for us to express some confidence in those citizens and let them have some confidence in our state government. I would ask your approval on this override motion. Thank you.
