this coming session off,' Senator Chambers of Omaha said in an interview. 'I am prepared to do that to keep anything from passing.'" I don't know what 47 other senators feel about a threat such as that but I, for one, will not tolerate or stand here and not vote for a cloture rule when a threat is made to 47 other senators, including myself, which would be 48. I definitely will vote to support Senator Moore. I think it is long past due, and I can't believe that any one of you sitting on the floor of the legislature will take a threat from any senator on the floor, and when he says he will hold up the whole session, Senator Chambers is very qualified, he is very capable. He has done it before. He will do it again, and there is no one on this floor that can compete with him to stop a filibuster when he starts one. So I urge you to support Senator Moore in his efforts. Thank you.
