SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Discussion, Senator Landis, with Senator Haberman on deck. Thank you. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President and members of the body, Senator Wesely, would you please respond to some questions?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Wesely, would you respond?

SENATOR WESELY: Sure.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Wesely, when I visited with you the other day, I indicated to you that there was a new fiscal note and gave you the figures and the old figures. Is there a new fiscal note?

SENATOR WESELY: The December 28, 1989, would be considered new, I would imagine.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I'm sorry, what did you say, Senator Wesely?

SENATOR WESELY: Senator Haberman, in our books there is a fiscal note dated December 28, 1989. I would imagine that would be, of course, the most current and I believe that would reflect the amendments on the budget bill last year.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Just to check it, you're looking at that fiscal note.

SENATOR WESELY: Mmm, hmm.

SENATOR HABERMAN: It shows...my notes here show, for example, to set up the hotline. I think the fiscal note showed 46 and the new one is 50,000. And the fiscal note showed 48 and the new one is 52,000. Is that what you're looking at? Is that...?

SENATOR WESELY: I don't see those in particular, but I...

SENATOR HABERMAN: Let's go to one more then. Fiscal and A bill both require 200,000 to fund the Early Childhood Program Training Fund 200,000.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah, that's the same, uh-huh.

SENATOR HABERMAN: The estimate of coordinating committee costs in Department of Education, 44,000 and 51,000. Are those two
