outside the Legislative Chamber, please return and record your presence. Senator Ashford. Senator Scofield, would you please record your presence. Senators Schmit and Wesely, Landis and Hall, the house is under call. Senator Chizek, the house is under call. Senator Wesely, Senator Schmit. Senator Senator Landis, the house is under call. Those members unexcused and not present, Senators Wesely, Schmit and Landis. Senator Chizek, check in, please. Senator Chambers, do you want to go ahead or.... Apparently Senator Landis is on his way. The Sergeant-at-Arms is looking. A roll call vote has been requested. The question again is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LR 8. Members, take your seats for a roll call vote. Proceed with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 288-89 of the Legislative Journal.) 11 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion fails. The call is raised. Anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Proceeding then to the next amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. This is your amendment, Senator, page 2, line 1, strike the word "capital" and insert "all homicide".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Chambers.
