

rule on an issue, I don't bash the court. That's the system, you live with it. But if there's a judge that's wrong, we have got other ways of taking care of judges that aren't behaving the way that we think we should. You look at the system. What have we got here right now? We have got a bill in position that's going to change our Constitution. It's not going to freeze anyone out of their appeal rights. They're always going to have the right to appeal and you and I in this body are going to have the right to determine where those appeals are going to go to. I appreciate your patience for the entire day and I want to leave you with one thought. Every one of you have probably got a bill that we're going to have to try to get to this session and we have spent one day, you have spent one day waiting to get to your bill, whether it's next or 10 down the line. But the people who are sitting in the appellate court system in this state are waiting two years. Do you know how long today was? Well, take it times two years because that's how long you're waiting to have your case heard by an appellate court and that doesn't take into consideration how long it took to get it tried to begin with. So, with that, I thank you again for your patience in this most important matter. I pledge to work with you. I will sit down with you at any time individually or as a group and we'll go through this and talk about it. Mr. Speaker, I would move to advance LR 8 to Select File.
