And the final one would be from line 19, on page 4, up to the end. I think those are six, but Ron...Senator Withem tells me that was seven, so I may have miscounted. To repeat, on page 1, lines 1 through 7. Line 8 through line 1 on page 2. Line 2 through line 15, page 2.

FRESIDENT: Right.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Line 16, page 2, up to line 2, page 3. Line 3, page 3, up to and including line 18, page 3. Line 19, page 3, up into line 18 and including line 18, page 4, and line 19 to the end. And Senator Withem was correct, that was seven. My apologies.

PRESIDENT: All right. Okay. Thank you. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I would like another ruling from the Chair.

PRESIDENT: Okay, in view...

SENATOR LABEDZ: Object.

PRESIDENT: Okay, I understood you object. In light of what has just happened on the previous ruling, I am going to rule that it is not divisible. Thank you. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I would like to make a motion to override the Chair at this time.

PRESIDENT: Okay, do you wish to discuss it?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: You bet I do. Before I do so, Mr. President, I would like to move that we adjourn.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. May we read some things in first from the Speaker...from the Clerk.
