opportunity and failing. I have failed in the past and I will fail in the future, but I do mind when a democratic majority says to a minority, we don't care. I move we override the decision of the Chair and I ask that we support that motion.

SENATOR LAMB PRESIDING

SENATOR LAMB: The Chair recognizes Senator McFarland. Senator McFarland. I don't see Senator McFarland. We'll move on to Senator Dierks. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS. I'm asking for a ruling on this, Senator Lamb, Mr. President, hasn't been adequate debate.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion by Senator Dierks is to call the question. There has only been one speaker on this motion, so we will deny the motion to call the question.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. Speaker, we have discussed the bracket motion on three different occasions. We have spent hours discussing the bracket motion. Nothing new in the way of evidence is going to be brought to this body that is going to change our minds. Let's vote on the issue. Let's get the bracket motion out of the way, let's get back to discussing the issue.

SENATOR LAMB: Next speaker. Senator McFarland has not returned to the Chamber. Senator Hefner. Senator Hefner is the next speaker. Senator Hefner does not seem to be in the Chamber. Senator Labedz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I move we adjourn until January 25th, nine o'clock in the morning. Oh, I'm sorry. Yes.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance whose Chair is Senator Landis to whom was referred LB 938 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. Your Committee on Agriculture whose Chair is Senator Rod Johnson
