PRESIDENT: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 857 advances. LB 874, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 874 was introduced by Senator Haberman. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 3rd, was referred to the Government Committee, which reports the bill to General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Haberman, please.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the body, this legislation was brought to me by the County Officials Association. It was advanced to the floor by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Six yes votes, no no votes, no amendments, no opponents. All it does is in the law now the law says that the county budget shall be submitted on or before July 15th each year. Another section of the law says it requires submission of the county budget no later than the first day of August each year. So the statutes are in conflict. All this bill does is says it changes the date that the budget shall be submitted on one date, August 1st each year. That's the bill. I would ask for your approval. And a question, Mr. President. Do I have to have 30 votes on this advancement, or in the end? What do you mean no?

PRESIDENT: Do you mean how many votes you have to have ...

SENATOR HABERMAN: It's got the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: Twenty-five votes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
