PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do you want to read the bill, Mr. Clerk, please? We are on Final Reading so we should return to our seats, please. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LR 8CA on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 8CA pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 819 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 4 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LR 8CA passes. We'll move on to General File. Mr. Clerk, do you wish to recognize the Speaker, please. Senator Barrett, please.
