office. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Before you all go to your seats for Final Reading, may I announce, please, that one of our members has a birthday today, and it is Senator Glenn Goodrich, I understand, and, Glenn Goodrich, Senator Goodrich, are those your little gift to us today? No? Well, if they were, we'd thank you for them, but...now, Senator Goodrich, we knew better than to put this to a vote, but we do wish you a happy birthday. Thank you. If you would take your seats, please, we will begin Final Reading. Okay, Mr. Clerk, LB 602 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: (Read LB 602 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 602 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 912 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 602 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 856.

CLERK: (Read LB 856 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 856 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 913-14 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 856 passes. LB 857.

CLERK: (Read LB 857 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 857 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
