Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the report offered by the Retirement Systems Committee.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is adopted. Senator Wesely's report, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely has three reports on various confirmations. The first one I have, Senator, is Stuart Embury to the Rural Health Manpower Commission and Alice Bartels to the Foster Care Review Board.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely, please.

SENATOR WESELY: Let me ask that that be divided and we take Dr. Embury up first.

PRESIDENT: All right. What was the first name, please?

SENATOR WESELY: Dr. Embury.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.
