solve the tire problem. It is as simple as that. You know, if this is a \$200,000 appropriation to the university to be used just for the tires, I would have a problem, too, but as Senator Beck says, it is research and development of a solution to the problem with tires, simple as that. It is one of those things that if you are going to pay the admission to go to the show for the whole crowd, you ought to at least be able to watch the movie. The tire people are buying the ticket to go in, they ought to at least be able to watch the movies. It is as simple as that. A quarter of the money should go to tire research, they are the ones paying for it. I urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Thank you, Senator Moore. That was the closing on the amendment to LB 163 offered by Senator Beck, and I understand, Senator Beck, you called for a roll call vote.

SENATOR BECK: Well, yes, sir, and if necessary, a call of the house.
