SENATOR SCHMIT: The Environmental Control Council, during the 1989 Special Session, heard the two individuals that you have...have been described here, Duane Liebsack, an appointee to the Environmental Control Council as a labor representative and Barbara Jo Bierman Batie is the appointment to fill the responsibility of the livestock division and those appointments are recommended unanimously I believe, yes, indeed, by the Legislature for approval at this time. And I would ask that they be approved.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that confirmation report.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is approved.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit, as Chair of the committee would report on the appointment of Mr. Randall Stinnette to the Games and Parks Commission.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, the Committee on Natural Resources desires to report favorably upon the appointment of Mr. Randall K. Stinnette to the Game and Parks Commission. Mr. Stinnette is a farmer and he has a broad background in Game and Parks type of activities, a member of the conservation groups and has a long interest in hunting and fishing and park activity and appears to be a very admirable addition to the Game and Parks and, therefore, the committee suggests that his appointment be confirmed and we would suggest a record vote.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the approval of the confirmation report and a board vote. So those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Report, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is adopted. Ladies and
