PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, we will take them one at a time. The Committee on Natural Resources desires to report favorably upon the appointments that we have listed, that have just been indicated by the Clerk. The committee suggests the appointments be confirmed by the Legislature and we suggest a record vote. Janet Elizabeth Bernard-Stevens, M.D. as a member of the Environmental Control Council. Unfortunately, Dr. Stevens, because of weather problems, was not able to be before the committee. She was represented by her husband, Senator Bernard-Stevens and, notwithstanding that representation, we did agree to report the nomination favorably. In all seriousness, she is a very fine person. She is highly qualified for her position on the council and the committee was unanimous in her recommendation that she be confirmed, and I would so move.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Morrissey, please. Well...the question is the adoption of the report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that portion of the report.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, the committee also met and heard Miss Connie Bunge who is also an appointee to the Environmental Control Council.
