369A, but before we do, Mr. Clerk, I'd like to take this opportunity to announce that Senator Moore has some guests in the south balcony. There are students there from Nebraska Lutheran School at Waco, Nebraska, and their sponsor. Would you all please rise and be recognized by the Legislature. Thank you for joining us. Also in the south balcony Senator Moore has some additional guests from Stromsburg and it is from Stromsburg High School and their sponsors. Would you all please rise and be welcomed. Thank you for joining us today. Mr. Clerk, LB 369A

CLERK: 369A, Mr. President, was a bill introduced by Senator Beyer. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill. Senator Conway would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (Conway amendment appears on page 1173 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Senator Chizek, excuse me, Senator Beyer, please. Thank you. Senator Conway, on the amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: I would like to move the amendment to LB 369A. It's an additional \$2,000 due to some amending that we did during the debate on the bill itself that brought me a \$2,000 bump into the Department of Motor Vehicles, program 70, and I move that amendment to 369A.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Thank you. There are no other lights on, Senator Conway, would you care to close? Senator Conway waives closing. The issue before you is the adoption of the amendment to 369A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 may, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Conway's amendment to the bill.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?
