SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, due to the circumstances, I would like to ask for a call of the house and I will take call in votes.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question before the house is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Members, please return to your desks and record your presence. Members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return and check in. The house is under call. Senator Moore, please. Call in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Robak voting yes. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Labedz...

SPEAKER BARRETT: Record.

CLERK: ...voting yes. 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The Conway amendment is adopted and the call is raised.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Back to the question of its advancement, Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move that LB 1094, as amended, be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir. Any discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of LB 1094. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The ayes have it. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 960, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 960, I have E & R amendments, first of
