SENATOR CROSBY: I wanted to speak on the resolution. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Langford.

SENATOR LANGFORD: Mr. President, I'd like to call the question.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. And the question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

SENATOR LANGFORD: Call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Call of the house has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 1 may to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber so that we may continue. Please look up to see if your light is illuminated. Senator Haberman, would you please record your presence. Looking for Senator Barrett, Senator Lamb, Senator Lynch, Senator Chambers, Senator Coordsen, Senator Hartnett, Senator Moore. Senator Scofield. Senator Langford, did you authorize call in votes?

SENATOR LANGFORD: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Yes, you do? Okay, call in votes are authorized.

CLERK: Senator Moore voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Labedz voting yes. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Lindsay voting yes. Senator Scofield voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 4 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Debate has ceased. Senator McFarland, would you please close on your amendment.
