people in jail? They belong in jail if they're murdering, raping, robbing, dealing in drugs or anything else, then by golly, let's give the police department...departments all across the state the tool with which they can help reduce the fabulous numbers of hours that they're putting in trying to identify these fingerprints so that they can tie a guilty person to the crime instead of spending all that money in that wasteful way. Let's give them a tool with which they can do it at a very brief time such as the way they did it in San Francisco and there will be a lot more than three states have this and when they get more states across this country that have it, then in that...at that time it will become...nationwide across this United States and the free flow of this kind of information can go from California to here where the drugs generally run from, is from California to here, and when we can spend a lot less time dinking around, wasting our time trying to do something in a backwoods way, we can then use a modern way of identifying them, put them away, convict them and put them away. I ask you, please, the Governor wants it, I ask you, please, let's adopt this thing and get known as the Legislature that's willing to fight crime in the State of Nebraska. Thank you.

SENATOR HANNIBAL PRESIDING

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Thank you. You heard the closing on the amendment to the committee amendments by Senator Goodrich. The question before you is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I'm asking for a call of the house and I want a roll call vote on this thing and I think it's time we all showed our colors. Thank you.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 1 may to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. All senators not on the floor, please return to the Chambers, the house is under call. Senator Lynch, please, Senator Lindsay, please, the house is under call. Senator Coordsen, would you record your presence, please. Senator Hefner, please.
