CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir. Have you matters for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Coordsen has amendments to LB 315 to be printed. (See pages 1350-53 of the Legislative Journal.)

And, Mr. President, I have a report from the Department of Roads, a statement of deposits to the Highway Cash Fund. That's filed pursuant to statute.

And, Mr. President, I have an appointment letter. That will be referred to the Reference Committee. Actually, I have three appointment letters that will be referred to the Reference Committee for confirmation hearings. (See pages 1353-55 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir. We have some guests of Senator Beck under the south balcony. The Chair is pleased to introduce a delegation from Omaha, from the Omaha Women's Chamber of Commerce.
